DOMESTIC POLITICS

3. (U) ALL EYES AND EFFORTS ARE FIRMLY FOCUSSED ON PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS WHICH WILL OCCUR IN LATE MAY OR EARLY JUNE. THE RULING DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PD) SHOULD RUN ON ITS RECORD: SINCE ASSUMING POWER AFTER DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS OF MARCH 1992,

PRESIDENT SALI BERISHA'S GOVERNMENT HAS UNDERTAKEN BOLD ECONOMIC REFORMS, COMPLETED A RADICAL MILITARY REORGANIZATION, REVAMPED THE COMMUNIST-ERA JUDICIAL SYSTEM, COMPLETELY REDISTRIBUTED AGRICULTURAL LAND, PRIVATIZED ALMOST ALL HOUSING, INTRODUCED A BILL OF (HUMAN) RIGHTS, AND PASSED LIBERAL INVESTMENT LAWS AND RELATED IMPLEMENTING LEGISLATION. THREE CROWNING FOREIGN POLICY ACHIEVEMENTS INCLUDE: THAT ALBANIA WAS ADMITTED TO THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE IN JULY 1995; THAT PRESIDENT BERISHA MET WITH PRESIDENT CLINTON IN WASHINGTON IN SEPTEMBER 1995; AND THAT PRESIDENT BERISHA HOSTED GREEK PRESIDENT STEPHANOPOULOS MARCH 21-22 CAPPING A LENGTHY WARMING TREND IN GREEK-ALBANIAN RELATIONS.

4. (U) THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PD) GOVERNMENT, LED BY PRIME MINISTER ALEKSANDER MEKSI, HAS A SOLID WORKING MAJORITY IN THE UNICAMERAL LEGISLATURE.

TIRANA 00619 01 OF 06 261053Z PAGE 03 THE MAJOR OPPOSITION PARTY, HEIRS OF THE FORMER COMMUNIST ALBANIAN LABOR PARTY, CHANGED ITS NAME TO THE SOCIALIST PARTY (PS) IN JUNE 1991. THE SOCIALISTS ENJOY SIGNIFICANT SUPPORT AND HAVE A FORMIDABLE ORGANIZATION AT THE LOCAL LEVEL. THEIR PARTY CHAIRMAN, EX-PRIME MINISTER FATOS NANO, REMAINS IN PRISON AFTER BEING JAILED IN 1993 ON CHARGES OF CORRUPTION DURING HIS THREE-MONTH TENURE IN 1991. THIS HAS BECOME A HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUE AS MANY ALBANIANS AS WELL AS INTERNATIONAL OBSERVERS CONSIDER HIM A POLITICAL PRISONER. GOVERNMENT HAS PASSED A BROAD "LUSTRATION" LAW THAT SEEKS TO PREVENT EX-COMMUNISTS AND OTHERS WHO COLLABORATED WITH THE OLD REGIME FROM HOLDING PUBLIC AND APPOINTED OFFICE.

5. (C) SINCE THE 1992 ELECTIONS, THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY HAS SUFFERED A SERIES OF DIFFICULTIES, BEGINNING WITH THE EXPULSION OF SEVERAL OF ITS PROMINENT MEMBERS, WHO WENT ON TO FORM SMALL BUT INFLUENTIAL OPPOSITION PARTIES. THE PD ALSO DID POORLY IN JULY 1992 LOCAL ELECTIONS. THE FAILURE OF A REFERENDUM TO APPROVE A NEW CONSTITUTION N NOVEMBER 1994 WAS A MAJOR BLOW TO THE PARTY, PRECIPITATING A CABINET RESHUFFLE AND EVENTUALLY THE EXPULSION OF PARTY CHAIRMAN EDUARD SELAMI. THE PARTY SEEMS TO HAVE RECOVERED ITS EQUILIBRIUM FROM THAT DEFEAT AND THE INTERNAL DISPUTES IT CREATED OR EXACERBATED. IN RECENT RELIABLE OPINION POLLS, THE

6. (C) MANY OBSERVERS, BOTH WITHIN AND OUTSIDE OF THE PD, PREDICT THE PD WILL HAVE A NEARLY IMPOSSIBLE TASK RETAINING A MAJORITY IN PARLIAMENT. DESPITE THE TREMENDOUS ECONOMIC GROWTH OCCASIONED BY THE BERISHA GOVERNMENT'S "SHOCK THERAPY," CONCOMITANT CORRUPTION, BUREAUCRATIC INEPTITUDE, AND CONTINUING INTERRUPTIONS IN WATER AND ELECTRICITY SUPPLIES HAVE DISILLUSIONED MANY VOTERS IMPATIENT TO ACHIEVE A "WESTERN" STANDARD OF LIVING AND POLITICAL DISCOURSE. OTHER OBSERVERS CITE SHORTCOMINGS IN THE AREA OF DEMOCRATIZATION AS ANOTHER REASON FOR VOTER DISAPPOINTMENT WITH THE PD. (SEE SECTION ON DEMOCRATIZATION, BELOW.)

- 8. (C) THE RECENT VISITS OF MINISTER OF DEFENSE ZHULALI TO THE U.S. HAVE BEEN SEEN HERE AS MAJOR POLITICAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS, AS HAS BEEN YOUR EARLIER VISIT TO ALBANIA. RECENT EXERCISES HAVE DEMONSTRATED OUR CONCRETE SUPPORT FOR THE ALBANIANS, AND SHOWED THEIR WILLINGNESS TO AID THE U.S. AS WELL. THE ALBANIANS WANT TO "GO AMERICAN", BUT IN THE MILITARY FIELD THEY FEEL THEY HAVE LITTLE MATERIALLY TO SHOW FOR ALL THEIR EFFORTS, GOOD WILL, AND COOPERATION. THE EXPANSION OF U.S. MILITARY ACTIVITY IN ALBANIA AND VISITS OF PRESIDENT BERISHA AND MINISTER ZHULALI TO WASHINGTON HIGHLIGHTED THIS ISSUE. ALTHOUGH WE DO NOT EXPECT THE MINISTER TO RAISE THE ISSUE, HE HAS AT TIMES FELT THAT HE HAS BEEN GIVEN CONFLICTING INFORMATION REGARDING COST, AVAILABILITY AND DELIVERY TERMS ON FMF AND DSAA-RELATED ITEMS.

PAGE 03 TIRANA 00619 02 OF 06 261054Z - THE PROPOSED ALBANIAN NATIONAL TRAINING CENTER REMAINS AT THE TOP OF MINISTER ZHULALI'S WISH LIST. HE HAD HOPED SOMETHING TOWARD THE NTC COULD HAVE BEEN PROVIDED PRIOR TO THE ELECTIONS. HE NOW SEEMS TO UNDERSTAND THIS WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE. NEVERTHELESS, WE ANTICIPATE THIS SUBJECT WILL BE RAISED. THE INITIAL SITE SURVEY FOR THE BIZA AREA WAS HELD 18-20 MAR BY EUCOM/SETAF, AND COMSIXTHFLT IS SCHEDULED TO CONDUCT A SURVEY OF SAZAN ISLAND IN MID-APRIL.

- IMET HAS BEEN THE ONLY SAO ACTIVITY IN ALBANIA UNTIL THIS TIME. LATER THIS MONTH, AN SAO OFFICE WILL OPEN AT THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE. THERE HAS BEEN MUCH INTEREST IN THE FMS/FMF PROCESS BY THE ALBANIANS. LOA'S FOR TWO 42' PATROL BOATS WERE DELIVERED TO MOD DURING FEBRUARY BWG. CONFUSION OVER TERMS HAS DELAYED EXECUTION. MINISTER ZHULALI MAY INQUIRE ABOUT OTHER LOA'S WHICH HAVE BEEN PROMISED.
- ALBANIA IS CURRENTLY THE NUMBER ONE RECIPIENT OF EXCESS DEFENSE ARTICLES. APPROXIMATELY 225 VEHICLES HAVE BEEN DELIVERED. DELIVERY OF AN ADDITIONAL 80 VEHICLES HAS BEGUN, AND 325 WERE INSPECTED THIS MONTH.
- THE MILITARY HOSPITAL WHICH WAS THE FOCUS OF "UJE KRISTAL" LAST SUMMER HAS BECOME AN ITEM OF INTEREST RECENTLY. THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE HAS RECENTLY REQUESTED ADDITIONAL WORK AT THE HOSPITAL TO

- DR. DENNY LANE (COL USA RETIRED) HAS BEEN IN PLACE AS THE DEFENSE ADVISOR TO THE ALBANIAN MINISTER OF DEFENSE SINCE MAY 95. HIS CONTRACT IS CURRENTLY BEING WORKED FOR RENEWAL BY USEUCOM J-5 SHOP.

WEATHER TRAINING NEAR DURRES IN LATE FEBRUARY.

- THE MILITARY LIAISON TEAM IS PLANNING TO CONDUCT APPROXIMATELY 120 TRAVELING CONTACT TEAM VISITS AND FAMILIARIZATION TOURS WITH ALBANIA DURING 1996. WHILE THE EVENTS COVER A WIDE RANGE OF TOPICS, AREAS OF SPECIAL EMPHASIS ARE PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION, NCO DEVELOPMENT, TRAINING AND TRAINING MANAGEMENT, PEACEKEEPING, DISASTER RELIEF, AIR DEFENSE, THE NAVY, AND THE MILITARY HOSPITAL. IN JANUARY, THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE ASKED FOR INFORMATION ON TWO TOPICS: U.S. MILITARY RULES FOR EARLY RETIREMENT AND THE PROCESS OF MILITARY PERSONNEL DETAILING. BOTH OF THESE WERE SUBMITTED FOR OUT-OF-CYCLE JCTP EVENTS IN ORDER TO ANSWER THE MINISTER'S QUESTIONS.
- THE NAVAL HYDROGRAPHIC CHARTING PROJECT HAS BEEN ONGOING FOR NEARLY TWO YEARS. THE ENTIRE ALBANIAN COAST HAS BEEN CHARTED BY THE USNS LITTLEHALES. THE CHARTS HAVE BEEN TURNED OVER TO THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE BY RADM GAFFNEY. THE HYDROGRAPHIC EQUIPMENT WHICH WAS DELIVERED TO THE ALBANIANS WAS RETURNED TO USS LASALLE IN DECEMBER. PLANS ARE FOR IT TO BE SENT BACK TO ALBANIA LATER THIS YEAR WHEN THE ALBANIAN NAVY AND THE U.S. WILL CHART THE AREA INSIDE THE HARBORS OF SARANDA AND VLORA. THIS COOPERATION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE INTO THE FUTURE. CINCUSNAVEUR AND COMSIXTHFLT ARE CURRENTLY WORKING TO ARRANGE FOR THE TRANSFER OF A SHIP TO

- THE JOINT MILITARY CARTOGRAPHY PROJECT BETWEEN THE ALBANIAN INSTITUTE OF MILITARY TOPOGRAPHY AND THE U.S. DEFENSE MAPPING AGENCY HAS ALSO BEEN UNDERWAY FOR ABOUT 2 YEARS. PRESENTLY, ALBANIA IS PRODUCING TOPOGRAPHIC MAPS THAT WILL BE PURCHASED BY THE U.S. BOTH NATIONS ARE BENEFITING FROM THIS COOPERATION WHICH INVOLVES TRAINING, SOME SUPPLIES AND MUCH JOINT WORK. DMA PERSONNEL VISITED ALBANIA LAST WEEK TO COORDINATE THE CARTOGRAPHY PROJECT.
- CINCUSNAVEUR AND COMSIXTHFLT ARE ARRANGING FOR U.S. AIRCRAFT TO FLY ON A LOW LEVEL ROUTE IN ALBANIA. A TEAM IS PLANNING TO VISIT ALBANIA IN EARLY APRIL TO FINALIZE THE PLANS.

10. (C) ALBANIA'S ECONOMIC INFRASTRUCTURE IS THE LEAST DEVELOPED IN EUROPE, AND PRESIDENT BERISHA WAS CORRECT WHEN HE ONCE DESCRIBED ALBANIA AS "A THIRD-WORLD COUNTRY." THE DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENT EMBARKED ON A PROGRAM OF "SHOCK THERAPY" THAT LED ALBANIA TO BE CONSIDERED SOMETHING OF THE STAR PUPIL OF THE IMF. THE AGREEMENT WITH THE IMF NOW HAS LAPSED, AND DISAGREEMENTS OVER SUCH ISSUES AS GROWING GOVERNMENT BUDGET DEFICITS AGGRAVATED BY ACROSS-THE-BOARD PAY RAISES FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES HAVE DELAYED A NEW AGREEMENT DIFFICULT. WHILE ALBANIA MET IMF GOALS IN THE INITIAL "STABILIZATION PHASE" AHEAD OF TIME AND BROUGHT INFLATION DOWN FROM 400 PER CENT TO NEAR ZERO
