8. THE SOCIALISTS ARE OPTIMISTIC AND CONFIDENT IN THEIR ORGANIZATION. THEY BELIEVE THAT POPULAR DISILLUSIONMENT WITH BERISHA HAS ONLY INCREASED SINCE ITS FIRST SURPRISING MANIFESTATION IN THE NOVEMBER 1994 CONSTITUTIONAL REFERENDUM.
