- 2. (C) SUMMARY: DURING A LUNCH WITH THE NEW MINISTER OF INTERIOR HALIT SHAMATA AUGUST 23, SHAMATA ASSURED THE CHARGE HE IS WORKING HARD TO REEDUCATE ALBANIA'S POLICE TO MAKE THEM MORE AWARE OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND TO COMBAT CORRUPTION. HE INDICATED CERTAIN HIGH LEVEL AS

WELL AS STREET OFFICERS WERE DISMISSED OR DEMOTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MAY 28 VIOLENCE. THE POLICE WILL WORK TO MAINTAIN PUBLIC ORDER DURING THE LOCAL ELECTIONS, BUT ONLY IN FRONT OF THE POLLING STATIONS UNLESS THE COMMISSION CHAIRMAN REQUESTS ASSISTANCE. SHIKU AGENTS WOULD NOT BE PRESENT AT THE POLLING STATIONS, THE MINISTER SAID. (C) WHEN CHARGE INQUIRED ABOUT THE DISPOSITION OF THE CASES OF THOSE POLICE ACCUSED OF BEATING DEMONSTRATORS ON MAY 28, SHAMATA SAID THAT SEVERAL HIGH LEVEL AND STREET OFFICERS HAVE BEEN DISMISSED OR DEMOTED. THE COURTS ARE HANDLING THEIR CASES INDIVIDUALLY. SHAMATA THOUGHT THESE ACTIONS WERE GOOD EXAMPLES OF HOW HIS MINISTRY WAS MOVING FORWARD, BUT HE WAS QUICK TO POINT OUT THAT THE OPPOSITION GATHERING WAS ITSELF ILLEGAL. HE ALSO NOTED THAT APPROPRIATE AUTHORITIES WERE INVESTIGATING SOCIALIST PARTY COMPLAINTS OF INTERFERENCE IN CAMPAIGN RALLIES IN TEPELENE, FIER, AND PERMET, BUT ARGUED THAT IN MOST CASES THE POLICE ACTED RESPONSIBLY IN ORDER TO PREVENT BLOODSHED.

(C) SHAMATA OFFERED ASSURANCES THAT DURING THE LOCAL ELECTIONS THE POLICE WILL WORK TO MAINTAIN ORDER, BE IN UNIFORM, AND ONLY ACT IN FRONT OF THE POLLING STATIONS UNLESS THE COMMISSION CHAIRMAN REQUESTS ASSISTANCE INSIDE. HE ADMITTED SOME INDIVIDUAL POLICE OFFICERS HAVE AND WILL CONTINUE TO OVERSTEP THE BOUNDS OF THEIR AUTHORITY, BUT THE MINISTRY IS DRAFTING A CODE

FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC MEETINGS WHICH THEY HOPE TO HAVE APPROVED BEFORE THE LOCAL ELECTIONS START OCTOBER 20. FURTHERMORE, THERE MAY BE CHANGES IN THE LOCAL ELECTION LAW ITSELF WHICH WOULD MIGHT AFFECT POLICE ROLES AND AUTHORITY.

ROLE OF SHIK (NATIONAL INFORMATION SERVICE)

- 7. (C) SHAMATA SAID THE ROLE OF THE NATIONAL INFORMATION SERVICE (SHIK) IS TO GET INFORMATION ABOUT ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL SABOTAGE IN THE COUNTRY. SHAMATA TOLD CHARGE SHIK PERSONNEL WOULD NEVER BE AROUND THE POLLING STATIONS. THE PARLIAMENT APPOINTED THE HEAD OF SHIK, SHIK REPORTS TO THE PARLIAMENT, AND THE PARLIAMENT DETERMINES WHEN TO INVOLVE SHIK IN A GIVEN SITUATION. SHIK'S CHIEF IS A CIVILIAN, SEPARATE FROM THE POLICE OR THE MILITARY. (NOTE: THE PRESIDENT ALSO PLAYS A STRONG ROLE IN SELECTING SHIK'S HEAD AND IN OVERSEEING THE ORGANIZATION'S ACTIVITIES, ALTHOUGH, AS SHAMATA NOTES, SUBJECT TO PARLIAMENTARY CONTROL. END NOTE.).
- 8. (C) SHAMATA SAID HE APPRECIATED ANY OUTSIDE ASSISTANCE THAT WOULD HELP IMPROVE THE STRUCTURE OF THE MINISTRY AND TO AID IN TRAINING AND EQUIPPING POLICE TO FIGHT AGAINST ORGANIZED CRIME. HE PRAISED PAST
