

## To President Ramiz Alia

- We support the democratic reforms initiated by President Alia and are for their acceleration. This was the goal of our peaceful protests.
- We demand the culprits who ordered the use of violence against the students. We demand that they be tried in Student City.
- We demand the creation of commission of students and doctors to verify the conditions of wounded students.
- We demand political pluralism as the highest level of democracy today, and in particular:
  - To allow the establishment of an Independent Democratic Organization of Students and Young Intellectuals. The status of this will be submitted for legalization to the Ministry of Justice.
  - We want this organization to have its own deputies in the National Assembly.
- To publish the charters of the United Nations, the Helsinki Charter 1 and 2, and the Charter of Paris.
- We demand freedom of the press and speech, without censorship.
- We demand clarification for public opinion about the truth of the student movement.
- We demand to find ways and solutions as fast and efficient as possible to leave the situation of economic crisis in which we find ourselves.
- We demand a meeting with President Alia.
- For the above, in defense of which are all students and which is also guaranteed by law, we demand that students are not penalized, categorically not subjected to violence and pressure, and not persecuted in an indirect way.

We call on all intellectuals, prominent individuals, all those who love ALBANIA to support our demands and to join us.
