3. REPUBLIKA GOT IT (PRACTICALLY) RIGHT, AFTER ALL. CHRIS HILL SIGNED A RESPONSE TO A LETTER TO THE WHITE HOUSE FROM REV. IMAM VEHBI ISMAIL, CHAIRMAN OF THE COALITION OF THE ALBANIAN- AMERICAN RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, CULTURAL AND SOCIAL SOCIETIES. CHRIS'S OCTOBER 4 LETTER INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH:

"IT IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT, HOWEVER, THAT GREECE PROVIDE FAIR TREATMENT TO ALBANIAN AND OTHER GROUPS LIVING IN ITS TERRITORY, AND THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF GREECE PUBLICLY DISASSOCIATE ITSELF FROM ALL EXTREMIST GROUPS. WE AGREE WITH YOU THAT THE GREEK GOVERNMENT'S REFUSAL TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE EXISTENCE OF ALBANIAN OR SLAVIC MINORITIES WITHIN GREECE DOES NOT ENHANCE THE PROTECTION OF THE LEGITIMATE RIGHTS OF THE GREEK MINORITY OUTSIDE OF GREECE."

REFERENDUM NOVEMBER 6 HOLDS SOME BENEFITS. NEW CRISIS WITH GREECE; IT PROVIDED INCENTIVES FOR PARTIES TO SEEK ACCOMODATION IN PARLIAMENT; THE

- THE RESULT WEAKENED PRESIDENT BERISHA AND THE RULING DEMOCRATIC PARTY (PD). STUNNED BY THE DEFEAT, PRESIDENT BERISHA INITIALLY CONSIDERED RESIGNING, AND SOME ADVISORS RECOMMENDED HOLDING IMMEDIATE ELECTIONS. MORE LIKELY, HOWEVER, BERISHA WILL FIGHT IT OUT, AND LOOK FOR A NEW STRATEGY FOR REDRAFTING AND ADOPTING A CONSTITUTION.
- BERISHA WANTS THE CONSTITUTION -- ANY DECENT CONSTITUTION -- TO FULFILL A CENTRAL PD CAMPAIGN PLEDGE AND A CONDITION FOR ALBANIA'S ADMISSION TO THE COUNCIL OF THE DEFEAT OF THE REFERENDUM WAS NOT A REJECTION OF THE CONSTITUTION. IT REFLECTED ECONOMIC DISCONTENT, CONCERN OVER TENSIONS WITH GREECE, AND A FEELING THAT PARLIAMENT SHOULD DEBATE THE CONSTITUTION.

NEXT STEPS

THE PD HAS PRIVATELY CONCEDED DEFEAT IN THE REFERENDUM,

OFFICIAL RESULTS HAVE NOT RELEASED. PRESIDENT BERISHA HAS REPEATEDLY STRESSED HE WILL ABIDE BY THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE.

INITIALLY DEVASTATED BY THE DEFEAT, BERISHA HAS REGAINED HIS BALANCE AND IS NOT LIKELY TO ACCEPT EARLY ELECTIONS,

BERISHA IS CONVINCED OPPOSITION PARTIES WILL BLOCK APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT CONSTITUTION IF IT IS BROUGHT BEFORE PARLIAMENT, BUT ALTERNATIVE COURSES APPEAR EVEN MORE PROBLEMATIC. REJECTION OF THE REFERENDUM MEANS OPPOSITION GROUPS IN THE 140-MEMBER PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY WILL EXPECT MAJOR CONCESSIONS TO SUPPORT EVEN AN AMENDED

VERSION OF THE CONSTITUTION.

TOLD AMBASSADOR LAKE HE WOULD RECOMMEND HOLDING IMMEDIATE ELECTIONS, BUT THAT WOULD PROBABLY FURTHER ERODE THE PD'S STRENGTH, WITHOUT DIRECTLY ADVANCING A CONSTITUTION.

BERISHA IS EXPLORING THE IDEA OF CONVENING A CONSTITUTIONAL ASSEMBLY, CROMPRISED OF THE PEOPLE'S ASSEMBLY PLUS A NUMBER OF SPECIALLY-ELECTED DELEGATES, CHARGED WITH DRAFTING A NEW CONSTITUTION. HOWEVER, THIS APPROACH WOULD CEDE CONTROL OF THE PROCESS TO A LARGE AND UNWIELDY BODY, AND ANY DOCUMENT IT PRODUCED WOULD PROBABLY BE PUT TO A NEW REFERENDUM.

NOTWITHSTANDING BERISHA'S CONVICTION THAT PARLIAMENT CANNOT AGREE ON A CONSTITUTION, THIS MAY BE THE BEST ROUTE FORWARD. IT WOULD FORCE THE PARTIES TO WORK TOGETHER, OR RISK BEING BLAMED FOR OBSTRUCTING A COMMON GOAL. IF BERISHA IS CORRECT IN PREDICTING THE SOCIALISTS WILL NOT COOPERATE, AT LEAST THAT PARTY WOULD BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE.

THE GOVERNMENT MUST DEMONSTRATE THAT ANY RENEWED EFFORT
