

2. THE NOVEMBER 6 REFERENDUM DEFEAT OF THE GOA'S DRAFT CONSTITUTION REVEALED A BASIC DISCONNECT BETWEEN AN INCREASINGLY ENTRENCHED GOVERNMENT-DEMOCRATIC PARTY LEADERSHIP AND A POPULATION DISSATISFIED WITH ECONOMIC AUSTERITY MEASURES AND CORRUPTION. VOTERS ALSO

RESENTED THE GOVERNMENT'S PATRONIZING ATTITUDE, SEEN IN THE INTENSE, RHETORIC-LADEN, PRO-CONSTITUTION CAMPAIGN.

3. PRESIDENT BERISHA IS EXPECTED TO MAKE CHANGES IN HIS GOVERNMENT WHILE TRYING TO FORGE A BROAD, INTERPARTY CONSENSUS ON THE PROCEDURE FOR ADOPTING A NEW CONSTITUTION. TO SATISFY THE ELECTORATE IN THE LONGER TERM, HE MUST REDUCE CORRUPTION AND ENSURE THAT ECONOMIC HARDSHIPS ARE SEEN TO BE SHARED BY ALL, NOT JUST THE HONEST. IN THE SHORTER TERM, HIS ROOM FOR MANEUVER ON KEY ISSUES, INCLUDING GREEK-ALBANIAN RELATIONS AND THE TRIAL OF THE OMONIA FIVE, MAY HAVE BEEN FURTHER LIMITED BY THE POPULAR REBUKE. END

#### GOVERNMENT LOST TOUCH

4. THE GOA'S FAILURE TO GET POPULAR APPROVAL OF A



TIRANA 03492 01 OF 02 010843Z PAGE 03 DRAFT CONSTITUTION IN THE NOVEMBER 6 REFERENDUM WAS UNEXPECTED AND BASED ON A NUMBER OF FACTORS, BOTH RELATED AND UNRELATED TO THE DOCUMENT ITSELF. GOVERNMENT'S COMPLETE SURPRISE AT THE RESULTS DEMONSTRATES A FUNDAMENTAL FAILURE OF COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE BERISHA GOVERNMENT AND THE ALBANIAN PEOPLE. THIS CAN BE PARTLY ATTRIBUTED TO THE DIMINISHED CAPACITY OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY'S LOCAL ORGANIZATION. DURING TWO AND A HALF YEARS OF RULE, THE PD LOST THE VERY GRASSROOTS APPEAL THAT BROUGHT IT TO POWER IN 1992. IT CAME TO DEPEND FAR TOO MUCH IN THE CHARISMA OF PRESIDENT BERISHA AS IT BECAME TOO CLOSELY IDENTIFIED WITH THE STATE POWER APPARATUS IN TIRANA. THE HORTATORY, LOW-CONTENT, AND PEP RALLY CHARACTER OF THE GOVERNMENT'S PRO CONSTITUTION CAMPAIGN PROBABLY TURNED OFF MANY VOTERS THAT HAD, IN EX-MINISTER GENC RULI'S WORDS, "DEMOCRATIZED THEMSELVES FASTER THAN THE GOVERNMENT, " AND REFUSED TO BE TAKEN FOR GRANTED.

ECONOMIC WOES: MISERY WANTS COMPANY

5. THE REFERENDUM BECAME A "SAFE" CONFIDENCE VOTE IN THE GOVERNMENT - A WAY TO PROTEST CURRENT POLICIES WITHOUT NECESSARILY OPTING FOR THE OPPOSITION.
BERISHA WAS CLEARLY AS INTERESTED IN AN ENDORSEMENT OF HIS PRESIDENCY AS HE WAS IN GIVING ALBANIA A CONSTITUTION. THE NEGATIVE RESULT DEMONSTRATES FIRST AND FOREMOST, POPULAR DISCONTENT WITH THE HARSH PRICE OF ALBANIA'S RELATIVELY SUCCESSFUL ECONOMIC

### THE HARD SELL BACKFIRED

- 6. A SECOND REASON FOR THE GOVERNMENT'S DEFEAT WAS SOMETHING THAT THE GOVERNMENT ITSELF COULD HAVE CONTROLLED MORE EASILY THAN THE ECONOMY: ITS CAMPAIGN FOR THE CONSTITUTION. THE VOTERS SEEM TO HAVE FELT THE SAME EERIE DEJA-VU THAT MANY FOREIGN OBSERVERS EXPERIENCED WATCHING THE BERISHA'S MASSIVE CAMPAIGN. ELECTRONIC MEDIA COVERAGE WAS MASSIVELY ONE-SIDED, WITH HOUR-LONG FOOTAGE OF BERISHA'S PRO-REFERENDUM RALLIES AGAINST THE FEW MINUTES ALLOWED TO THE OPPOSITION.
- 7. ANOTHER MAJOR REASON FOR THE REFERENDUM RESULT WAS THE NATURE OF THE DRAFT CONSTITUTION ITSELF. MOST PEOPLE DOUBTLESS EITHER DID NOT READ OR DID NOT UNDERSTAND THE DOCUMENT. THEY WERE EASILY SWAYED BY OPPOSITION CLAIMS, BROUGHT HOME IN PARTICULAR BY THE SOCIALIST PARTY'S STRONG LOCAL ORGANIZATION, THAT THE DRAFT WOULD GIVE THE PRESIDENT FAR TOO MANY POWERS,

ESPECIALLY AT THE EXPENSE OF THE JUDICIARY, WOULD PERPETUATE THE CLOSE PARTY-GOVERNMENT RELATIONSHIP THAT VOTERS ASSOCIATE WITH THE BAD OLD DAYS.

## WORRIED GREECE WOULD SHUT DOOR

8. MANY VOTERS, ESPECIALLY IN THE SOUTH OF ALBANIA, RECOGNIZED THAT GREECE HAD TAKEN STRONG EXCEPTION TO CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE DRAFT. EVEN THOSE WHO WERE NOT PARTICULARLY CONCERNED ABOUT THE DRAFT ARTICLE PUTTING TOUGH QUALIFICATIONS ON RELIGIOUS LEADERS FEARED THAT PASSAGE OF THE CONSTITUTION WOULD RESULT IN A STRONG GREEK REACTION. MANY WERE ANXIOUS THAT GREECE WOULD LIMIT OR CLOSE THE EMIGRATION SAFETY VALVE TO THE SOUTH, USED BY HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF ALBANIANS AND THE SOURCE OF MILLIONS OF DOLLARS OF REMITTANCES.

## GOVERNMENT SHAKEUP

9. HAVING CONSIDERED AND REJECTED THE OPTIONS OF PRESIDENTIAL RESIGNATION OR CALLING NEW ELECTIONS, THE GOVERNMENT IS UNDERTAKING MAJOR HOUSEKEEPING IN THE COMING DAYS. SEVERAL MINISTERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE REPLACED. IN THIS WAY BERISHA HOPES TO BLUNT CRITICISM OF GOVERNMENT CORRUPTION. LEADERSHIP CHANGES ARE ALSO POSSIBLE AT DEMOCRATIC PARTY HEADQUARTERS. NO MAJOR CHANGES TO THE ECONOMIC AUSTERITY PROGRAM HAVE YET BEEN SUGGESTED, ALTHOUGH POPULAR DISCONTENT MAY RISE YET FURTHER AS ELECTRICITY AND FUEL SUPPLIES ARE SQUEEZED CONFIDENTIAL

# INTERPARTY AGREEMENT SOUGHT

10. THE GOA HAS ATTEMPTED TO GET INTER-PARTY AGREEMENT ON A PROCEDURE FOR DEVISING AND ADOPTING ANOTHER CONSTITUTIONAL DRAFT. WHILE BERISHA EXPRESSES OPTIMISM THAT A BROAD AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED ON THE MODE OF ADOPTING A NEW DRAFT, THE OPPOSITION HAS BEEN CLEAR THAT ANY DRAFT MUST BE APPROVED BY THE PARLIAMENT. THE GOVERNMENT, MEANWHILE, INSISTS THAT THE CONSTITUTION CAN ONLY BE ACCEPTED BY ANOTHER PLEBESCITE.

# GOVERNMENT LESS RESPONSIVE ON OUR ISSUES

11. WHILE BERISHA HAS DECIDED TO HANG TOUGH, GOVERNMENT CHANGES ARE IN THE OFFING AND THE POLITICAL SITUATION WILL REMAIN FLUID FOR THE NEXT FEW WEEKS. THIS DOES NOT BODE WELL FOR ANY SUSTAINABLE GOA INITIATIVE FOR DIALOGUE WITH GREECE AS WELL AS FOR ANY DRAMATIC GESTURE OF EXECUTIVE CLEMENCY AS THE TRIAL OF THE FIVE ETHNIC GREEK "OMONIA" LEADERS REACHES THE FINAL APPEAL.

# BUT DEMOCRACY HAS ITS DAY

12. THE GOOD NEWS IS THAT THE ALBANIAN PEOPLE WERE CONFIDENT ENOUGH TO SEND A BOLD MESSÂGE AGAINST THE COZY GOVERNMENT-DEMOCRATIC PARTY RELATIONSHIP AND THE ATTENDANT PERCEPTION THAT IT IS THE BREEDING PLACE OF INCREASING CORRUPTION. BERISHA SHOULD NOT

# FIGHTING CORRUPTION TO SELL AUSTERITY

13. BERISHA IS UNLIKELY TO BE ABLE TO SIGNIFICANTLY SOFTEN ECONOMIC AUSTERITY MEASURES WITHOUT RISKING INTERNATIONAL AID AND LONG TERM ECONOMIC VIABILITY. HE CAN DO FIGHT CORRUPTION AND BUILD THE PERCEPTION THAT HARDSHIP IS ENDURED MORE BROADLY, IN HOPES THAT ALBANIANS WILL REAP THE FIRST FRUITS OF THEIR PATIENCE BEFORE THE 1996 ELECTIONS.
