RECENT TERRORIST INCIDENTS, THEY SUGGESTED TO THE REPORTER, WERE PROBABLY STAGED BY THE SERBS TO DISCREDIT KOSOVO'S ALBANIAN COMMUNITY. YET NONE OF THESE DOUBTS LEAVENED HEDGES' ARTICLE, WHICH WAS AUTHORITATIVE IN IDENTIFYING A TERRORIST ORGANIZATION, IGNORING THE POSSIBILITY PAJAZITI COULD HAVE HAD OTHER NOCTURNAL PURSUITS, SUCH AS DRUG RUNNING. ACCORDING TO THE INTERPRETER, HE ALSO PLANTED A QUOTE BY ASKING PAJAZITI'S FATHER IF HE WERE PROUD THAT HIS SON DIED FIGHTING FOR KOSOVO'S LIBERATION.
