ACCUSE U.S. AND GREECE IN TELEVISED

SPEECH TO PARLIAMENT

1. (U) CLASSIFIED BY DCM ROBERT F. CEKUTA.

REASON: 1.5 (B).

DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (SHIKU), BASHKIM GAZIDEDE MADE A PRESENTATION BEFORE THE ALBANIAN PARLIAMENT MARCH 26 IN WHICH HE IMPLICATED THE U.S., GREECE, AND YUGOSLAVIA AS HAVING AN INTEREST IN CAUSING THE

UNREST IN ALBANIA IN ORDER TO MEET THE GOALS OF A 1990 PLAN ("LOTOS") TO "LIBERATE ALBANIA FROM THE ALBANIANS." HE ALSO REPEATEDLY MENTIONED NICHOLAS GAGE ("...WHO HAS EXPRESSED HIS VIEWS TO HIGH U.S. OFFICIALS"), THE GREEK LOBBY IN AMERICA, AS WELL AS CURRENT EFFORTS BY GAGE, OMONIA REPRESENTATIVES, AND OTHER "SEGMENTS OF FOREIGN SECRET SERVICES" WHO HAVE SUPPORTED THE MOVEMENT TO RECRUIT ALBANIANS TO WORK IN A "PAN-EPIRIOTIC" EFFORT.

3. (C) GAZIDEDE, WHO FOCUSED ON "...ENEMIES OF ALBANIA WHO WANT TO BREAK UP THE COUNTRY," ALSO STATED "...NICHOLAS GAGE HAS BEEN HELPED A LOT BY A FOREIGN DIPLOMAT IN TIRANA WHO WAS ALSO THE ONE WHO SECURED FUNDS FOR THE KOHA JONE NEWSPAPER."

PAGE 03 TIRANA 00660 01 OF 02 271752Z GAZIDEDE ALSO MENTIONED THAT SOME PYRAMID SCHEMES WERE FUNDED FROM "...FOREIGN SECRET SERVICES." HE CHARGED THE XHAFERRI AND POPULLI FUNDS IN THIS REGARD AND ALLEGED DISCHARGED MILITARY OFFICERS AND FORMER SIGURIMI AGENTS WERE INVOLVED IN THESE OPERATIONS. HE CLEARLY IMPLIED THAT THE COLLAPSE OF THESE FUNDS WAS MANIPULATED FROM THE OUTSIDE. GAZIDEDE DENIED THAT MEMBERS OF THE SHIK PROVOKED ANYONE AT ANY TIME.

- 4. (C) AT THE END OF THE SPEECH, SPEAKER OF THE PARLIAMENT PJETER ARBNORI, IN AN A VERY UNUSUAL AND DIRECT REBUTTAL OF GAZIDEDE'S STATEMENTS, SAID: "THE GREEK MINORITY IN ALBANIA CANNOT BE TOUCHED OR VIOLATED. THE RELATIONS WITH GREECE ARE AS GOOD AND EXCELLENT AS THEY HAVE BEEN DURING THESE LAST YEARS."
- 5. (C) DURING THE QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD GAZIDEDE AVOIDED ANSWERING NUMEROUS INQUIRIES ABOUT THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE AND FORMER MINISTER ZHULALI. HE DENIED ACCUSING THE CURRENT GREEK GOVERNMENT OF ANYTHING, BUT SAID HE BROUGHT FORTH THIS INFORMATION BECAUSE "...EVERYONE NEEDS TO KNOW THE TRUTH." HE STATED HE COULD NOT SAY WHAT THE EU OR U.S. THOUGHT ABOUT ALBANIA AND REFUSED TO ANSWER A QUESTION ABOUT DIFFERENT LOBBIES' POSSIBLE INFLUENCE IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

PAGE 04 TIRANA 00660 01 OF 02 271752Z GOVERNMENT, SO THAT INFORMATION MUST STILL BE AVAILABLE. HE DID NOT WANT TO ANSWER A QUESTION ABOUT POSSIBLE INVOLVEMENT OF ALBANIAN POLITICIANS IN THE PYRAMIDS. GAZIDEDE DID ADD THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF NATIONAL RECONCILIATION HAS "... EVERY POSSIBILITY TO STABILIZE THE SITUATION. SO FAR IT HAS DONE A GOOD JOB."

7. (C) PARLIAMENTARIANS IN THE DISCUSSION PERIOD AFTERWARDS GAVE MIXED MESSAGES. PD DEPUTY BLERIM CELA, HEAD OF THE STATE AUDITING SERVICE AND CLOSELY IDENTIFIED WITH PRESIDENT BERISHA, UNDERSCORED THE POWER OF THE GREEK LOBBY IN U.S. POLITICS. HE ADDED THAT ALL OF PRESIDENT CLINTON'S ADVISERS ARE GREEK. HE ACCUSED AMBASSADOR LINO OF LYING ABOUT U.S. POLICY TOWARD ALBANIA AND ACCUSED THE U.S. OF OPENLY PLOTTING FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF THE COUNTRY. THIS IS THE ONLY MESSAGE WHICH GOT APPLAUSE FROM SOME IN THE ROOM. ONE ADDITIONAL PD DEPUTY BACKED THIS ANTI-U.S. LINE. TWO OTHER PD MEMBERS SAID ALBANIA SHOULD "...STOP SEEKING FOREIGN ENEMIES."

FINALLY, TWO PD DEPUTIES OPENLY ASKED FOR U.S. SUPPORT AND FRIENDSHIP TO CONTINUE.

- 8. (C) THE MOST SUPPORT CAME FROM SABRI GODO, REPUBLICAN PARTY CHAIRMAN. GODO REFUTED GAZIDEDE'S EXPLANATIONS AS "SHAMEFUL." HE SAID ANY EXPLANATION WHICH IMPLICATES THE U.S. IS WRONG AND IRRESPONSIBLE. "LET AMERICA CONTINUE ITS NOBLE MISSION OF PROTECTING AND DEVELOPING DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS AND LET US FOCUS ON OUR RESPONSIBILITIES."
- EOUALLY FORCEFUL, HUMAN RIGHTS PARTY (C) CHAIRMAN VASIL MELO -- NORMALLY SOFT-SPOKEN AND VERY LOW-KEY -- VEHEMENTLY DECLARED THAT GAZIDEDE'S REPORT WAS THE MOST SCANDALOUS HE HAD EVER HEARD. HE SAID ALBANIANS HAD ALWAYS LOOKED TO FIND FAULT IN OTHERS FOR THEIR OWN PROBLEMS. HE ACCUSED GAZIDEDE OF SLINGING ABOUT RUMORS INSTEAD OF FACTS. WHAT, MELO ASKED, ABOUT THE NOTORIOUS REPUTATION SHIK HAS AMONG THE PEOPLE? HE ALSO REMINDED THE ASSEMBLY ABOUT THE 300,000 ALBANIANS LIVING AND WORKING IN GREECE AND ASKED RHETORICALLY WHY GAZIDEDE HAD FORGOTTEN ABOUT ALL THE SUPPORT THE GREEK GOVERNMENT HAS GIVEN TO ALBANIA. MELO SAID EMPHATICALLY IT WAS A GOOD CONFIDENTIAL
