- SUMMARY: THERE IS SOME ROMANIAN DOUBT ABOUT THE SHEHU SUICIDE STORY. A PRINCIPAL WESTERN "ALBANIAN WATCHER" IN BUCHAREST, THE FINNISH EMBASSY, SHEDS LITTLE LIGHT ON THE QUESTION. THE ROMANIAN PRESS HAS THUS FAR IGNORED THE EVENT. END SUMMARY.
- (U) THE ROMANIAN PRESS HAS NOT MENTIONED THE DEATH OF ALBANIAN PREMIER MEHMET SHEHU. THE LAST MENTION HERE OF SHEHU WAS IN "SCINTEIA" ON DECEMBER 17 IN A REPORT ON THE VISIT (DECEMBER 16 AND 17) OF ROMANIAN FOREIGN TRADE MINISTER CORNEL BURTICA TO TIRANA FOR THE SIGNING OF THE 1982 ROMANIAN-ALBANIAN TRADE PROTOCOL. BURTICA CALLED ON SHEHU AND, "IN A FRIENDLY ATMOS-PHERE, " HAD "TALKS ABOUT DEVELOPING ECONOMIC

MENTIONED SHEHU'S "DEATH." THE MINISTER QUICKLY PICKED UP ON THE WORD SAYING "I'M GLAD TO SEE YOU USED THE WORD 'DEATH", "THUS IMPLYING SOME HIGH LEVEL ROMANIAN DOUBT OVER THE SUICIDE STORY.

THE FINNISH AMBASSADOR IN BUCHAREST IS ACCREDITED TO TIRANA. THE FINNISH DCM VISITED TIRANA IN LATE NOVEMBER. IN COMMENTING TO US ABOUT SHEHU'S DEATH, HE SAID THAT DURING THE VISIT HE TALKED WITH GREEK, KNENCH, EGYPTIAN, ITALIAN AND TURKISH COLLEAGUES RESIDENT IN TIRANA. NOT ONE OF THEM EVEN ALLUDED TO ANY POSSIBLE SHEHU PROBLEMS, SHAKE-UP RUMORS, OR POWER SHIFTS. THE FINNISH EMBASSY HERE HAD NO EXPLANATION FOR THE EVENT, NOTING ITS IMPRESSION THAT SHEHU'S COUNCIL OF MINISTERS AND POLITBURO POSITIONS HAD APPEARED SOLID AND THAT WHATEVER "YOUNGER INFLUENCES" WERE BEING FOLT IN ALBANIA, HE WAS STILL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MAJORITY POWER POSITIONS. THE COMMENTS OF THE ALBANIAN AMBASSADOR IN BUCHAREST REGARDING "NO CONDOLENCES, NO MOURNING, AND THE DISGRACE OF SUICIDE, " APPEAR TO FOLLOW THE SAME LINE THE ALBANIANS ARE USING ELSEWHERE.
